It's a place that **seeks justice** by providing care and support to children with disabilities and complex medical needs that they cannot get elsewhere. Allowah is one way your church gets to show that we believe all people are made in the image of God. Because we know that people living with disabilities are made in the image of God and have infinite value, and we strive to show them that every day at Allowah. The children we care for are often 'unseen' and their families come to us so tired of being 'unheard' in their journey to find the help they need. The care and support we are able to provide makes a world of difference in the lives of these families - and we offer it in a way that demonstrates the character of God.

Allowah does not receive any block government funding. Many families cannot afford to pay for private health insurance, cover the gap if they do have private health or cover the gaps in NDIS funding. Without your financial support, Allowah could not continue to run.
