Just think of the Samaritan on the Road to Jericho. Just one man. Not an important man. Not a huge organisation with a complex plan of action to help all the needy in the world. But a man who had mercy on one who others had walked past. A man who took care of someone who otherwise would have had no care.

### History

The first Social Service Committee of the Presbyterian Church in NSW was formed in 1912 to carry on the work being done by deaconesses at the Palmer Street Church in Woolloomooloo.

The work had formally begun in 1906, with the appointment of Miss Eva Holland as the state's first deaconess, to serve the needs of people living in one of Sydney's poorest neighbourhoods.

The social service ministries in the Presbyterian Church in NSW have changed and evolved over the course of the 20th century. Now as 'Jericho Road', God has shaped our little organisation into what it is today - a place where we do the big and small to support those in need!




